### Public Officials

**SLMPD PO Jon Amesquita**-crime in Clifton Heights continues to be low. PO Amesquita has been able to spend more time in the neighborhood but that will change as summer comes. He has a license reader available to him that helps spot abandoned or stolen cars that have been reported.

**Bret Narayan Alderman**- Narayan reported there is no plan to begin construction on the Quick Trip at Jamieson and Arsenal despite the tear down of the abandoned homes. Regarding the comfort station in the park there is now an engineering report stating that it will have to be demolished and rebuilt. The million-dollar price tag is questionable. Several agencies would have to approve the plans, including Cultural Resources. It is unclear what the cost will be until bids are received. The current ability to walk on the roof of the new comfort station will not happen. Alderman Narayan says that electricity for the fountains is a priority and there will be some sort of bathroom by this summer. Alderman Narayan also discussed several board bills that cover street repairs and utility companies, sunshine law compliance, living wage compliance and placing liens on vacant property in disrepair to more effectively deal with this problem.
