Bret Narayan Alderman- Narayan reported there is a bid out to split the Nic must be comprised of people who live in the neighborhood. The city will then correspond with the neighborhood association instead of posting notices on telephone poles. These have been sent to the mayor. BB 60 will make it easier to build small living quarters on your property, like a "mother in law suite". It was requested that the bill not allow these to be used as short-term rentals.

Speakers Nick Kimble State Rep 82nd District-the state has approved \$100 million dollars for tornado relief and twenty-five million for housing.
